The Upper School Program is designed to challenge learners, while simultaneously supporting them to actualize their potential. We provide an academically and intellectually challenging program that empowers our students to cultivate a life of purpose.

Student-centered to its core, the program enables students to pursue a NEASC accredited American diploma with opportunities to take Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Additionally, we are an International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP) candidate school and expect to offer the IBDP diploma beginning in September 2024.

The Classroom Experience

Team Model

The Upper School experience culminates in the Grade I2 Capstone - an interdisciplinary project that requires students to demonstrate their cumulative learning.

At the end of each grade level, students complete smaller capstone experiences that prepare them for success in completing this Grade I2 hallmark.
